DAD-582 – Professor (tenure track) Tier 2 Canada Research Chair (beginning July 1, 2018)

The Department of Applied Sciences of the Université du Québec à Chicoutimi (UQAC), is inviting applications for a tenure track opportunity to apply for a Tier 2 Canada Research Chair position on applied geochemistry of ore deposits. The selected candidate will work in collaboration with the Institutional Research Chair in Archean metallogeny financed by the Canada First Research Excellence Fund R&D project Metal Earth and led by Laurentian University in Sudbury, Canada.

UQAC is a thriving francophone educational and research institution located in the Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean area in the Québec province, Canada. The university is located near outstanding geological terranes (Archean Abitibi greenstone belt), gold deposits and Cu-Zn-(Au) massive sulfides. The Earth Sciences Unit includes one Canada Research Chair in magmatic metallogeny, two analytical laboratories « Laboratoire des Matériaux Terrestres » (LabMaTer) and the « Laboratoire de métallogénie expérimentale et quantitative » (LAMEQ) and hosts the CONSOREM, a mineral exploration research consortium. The selected candidate will have access to a world class laboratory, equipped with q-LA-ICP-MS, Carbon/Sulfur analyzer, cleanroom, cathodoluminescence, solution q-ICP-MS, micro-XRF, etc.

Tier 2 Canada Research Chairs (CRC) are tenable for five years and renewable once. They are held by exceptional emerging researchers, acknowledged by their peers as having the potential to become leaders in their field.
